RE: PROPOSED VISIT TO BLACKPOOL ZOO

In conjunction with our class studies this term it is proposed that classes 1VK and 1HW will be visiting Blackpool Zoo on Thursday, 11th June 2015. We will leave school at 9.15am and return by 3.30pm, travelling with Redline Travel, Penwortham.
